

## CSA's Leadership Café's "A BIGGER Picture"



An invitation to go on a journey to explore both "WHO you are"™ when in lead and the "BIGGER" landscape within which you lead in the company of fellow travellers

Learning to lead with clarity, courage, compassion and wisdom is a long and often lonely road. Learning to lead from "WHO we are" when faced with numerous pitfalls is a road less travelled. As David Whyte wrote *"work is where we can both MAKE or BREAK ourselves.... we shape the world and in turn are shaped by it"*

CSA Leadership Café's offer leaders and people professionals a rare and welcome opportunity to come together in the safe company of fellow travellers to explore "WHO they are"™ when they lead and reflect on the bigger landscape of economic, societal and ecological turbulence within which they lead.

Hosted by a CSA super-Visor™ 5 leaders come together to create a small reflective learning community which meets 4 times a year either face to face or via skype. The Cafes can be formed either within sectors or across different organizations, countries and/or cultures. Logistics are agreed as each café comes together.

Through story telling participants learn to mine the wisdom, challenge and companionship of their fellow travellers to attend to their own development as a person who is also a leader IN the context of their life and work. Cafes help leaders to:

- WHO am I in this?
- Explore the learning from critical incidents
- Detect the deeper patterns in self and in the world at

work

- Come home and celebrate "all of "WHO" and are "BECOMING" in their life and work
- Learn how to keep their heart, soul and commitment alive
- Clarify their purpose and what gives meaning to their lives
- Enjoy the wisdom, inspiration and companionship of fellow travellers

Leaders report the relief and joy of having the rare opportunity to pause to make sense of all that is happening from which new insights, perspectives, and meaning emerge for elegant action in the company of fellow travellers. They learn how to model CSA's relational and conversational approaches which sit at the heart of being a human being who is also a leader. They report new ways of seeing which enables them to work successfully with greater clarity, courage and humanity.
